   Nutrition, Livelihood, Women Empowerment, Relief
   Operation & Environment Protection.
- We have acquired all mandatory certifications to secure CSR Funding and Government funding which includes –
   80G and 12A Certification, CSR 1 Approval and NGO Darpan Registration.

# Key Initiatives

# Women Empowerment with 4S

### 1.SABLA (Training Programs)

Yash Samiti organised different skill development training programmes for professional freedom under the project SABLA for domestic help & women. About **300 WOMEN BENEFICIARIES.** 

#### 2.SAKSHAM

Yash Sewa Samiti organised Free Yoga Classes in park & self defence workshops in schools and park to make women mentally strong & to equip women with basic self-defense techniques, ensuring their safety and confidence in public spaces. Over **1000 beneficiaries**.

#### 3.SAKHI BAITHAKS

Yash Sewa Samiti conducted different awareness sessions workshops etc in Anganwadis, Parks, Chaupals etc. to educate adolescent girls & women about Menstrual Hygiene, nutrition etc. **1500** beneficiaries.

#### 4.SELF HELP GROUP

SHG provide micro finance to groups to facilitate the process of self-empowerment. SHGs promote savings and credit initiatives which enable them to access financial capital & start income generating activities. They helped each other. Over **250 beneficiaries** 

#### **Education for All**

Education is a cornerstone of our work, ensuring no child is left behind.

#### 1.STATIONERY AND UNIFORM DISTRIBUTION:

Over 500 children received school bags, books, and uniforms to prevent school dropouts.

#### 2.REMEDIAL CLASSES:

Regular classes for children of domestic help bridged learning gaps, enabling them to excel in their studies in schools & at different centres. **200 beneficiaries** 

#### 3.FINANCIAL HELP

We helped children of domestic help to pay their fees in private schools because they can't go to far away Govt. schools due to their working parents. 15 beneficiaries.

#### **Health for All**

Access to healthcare remains a priority for us because it is a basic human right.

#### 1.HEALTH CAMPS:

Many Health Camps were conducted in marginalized areas, providing free medical check-ups, medicines, and nutrition advice for Community. Over **610 beneficiaries.** 

#### 2.PERIOD AWARENESS SESSIONS:

Awareness workshops & FREE PAD DISTRIBUTION for adolescent girls and women were organized in Aganwadis, Parks, NGO premises emphasizing menstrual hygiene. Over **2800 beneficiaries** 

### 3.IMMUNITY KITS/HYGIENE KITS

We distributed IMMUNITY KITS & HYGIENE KITS to children & families of domestic Help Over 100 beneficiaries

#### 4. NUTRITION DRIVES:

Distribution of healthy food packets and awareness about balanced diets supported better health outcomes for underserved communities. Over **450 beneficiaries**


